

Supply List for 2020–21

Required for High School

- 5 reusable and washable masks (minimum)**
- Pencil Case (preferably three ring)
- Helmet if using a bicycle, scooter or anything with wheels on campus
- Inexpensive earbuds or headphones
- Calculator-TI-84 or TI-82 Plus
- Pencil Case (preferably three ring)
- Rocketbook Smartbook, available in school student store (Recommend 2 per student)
- Pilot Frixion pens, available in school, student store (Recommend 2 per student)
- Planner or diary, if desired (students will also use an electronic calendar/planner)

Device/Laptop requirements

New students must bring their own laptop. It must run either Windows10 or MacOSX 10.3 (High Sierra)

Concert Attire:

- Girls: Plain black top or blouse, black skirt or dress trousers, dark shoes. Hemlines must reach the knee. Shoulders must be covered (leggings, yoga pants, jeans, and skirts/dresses above the knees are not appropriate).
- Boys: Plain black long-sleeved shirt, belted black trousers, black dress shoes with dark socks.

Athletics Equipment Requirements

- Track and field running spikes (for anyone interested in training for track)

- Soccer boots/cleats and shin guards (for anyone interested in soccer or rugby)
- Rugby mouth guard and head / shoulder pads (for anyone interested in rugby)

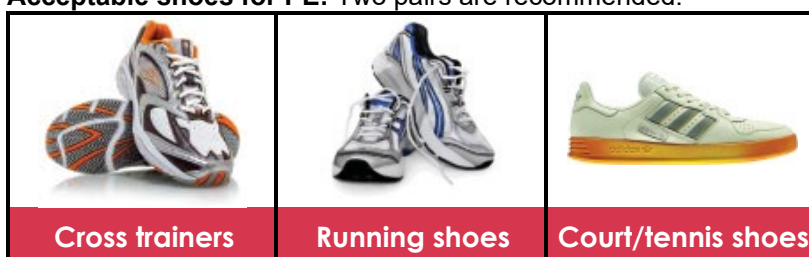

Physical Education (PE) Uniform:

By emphasizing safety, neatness and consideration of others in dress and grooming, we can ensure a focus on learning and contribute to positive self-esteem in our students. ICS does not currently have a required uniform; however, respect for our multicultural community, conservative host culture and active learning environment remains central to our dress code. Interpretation of the dress code is at the discretion of the principal and his/her decision is final.

Acceptable Dress

- Clean jeans, “skinny jeans” or trousers/pants that fit.
- Leggings (solid, opaque, thick material) when worn with a conservatively long, loose top that extends to the mid-thigh only.
- Shorts, skirts, or dresses that extend at least $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way to the knee.
- Tops or shirts with sleeves that cover the shoulders and midriff
- Athletic or casual shoes or sandals
- A hat for the sun that can be removed in class

Unacceptable Dress

- Loose and los-slung pants/trousers
- Clothing that is too tight, too short or too revealing
- Sleeveless, transparent or open-back tops
- Visible underwear
- Ripped clothing
- Clothing promoting alcohol, tobacco or drug use, sex, cults, violence or any other offense image or language.
- Wearing sunglasses in class

International Travel

All ICS sports teams and activity groups/clubs that travel internationally are required to wear the following on the airplane:

- Khaki colored pants/trousers are required for all ISSEA sports and Cultural Conventions. These are best purchased from overseas for fit and comfort. The school has some for sale but has very limited stock and has discontinued purchasing these items. Khaki pants (recommended to purchase before coming to Ethiopia)
- Dress shoes (recommended to purchase before coming to Ethiopia)
- Travel shirt (available at the school store)
- Golf clubs and equipment if interested on being on the ISSEA golf team

Athletic / Performing Arts Awards Ceremony Dress Requirements

All students that play on a sports team and / or are involved in performing arts (band / choir / drama) are required to attend their season's awards ceremony and dress code is smart casual.

- Boys: formal pants, formal shoes and dress socks, button up collared shirt and a tie, a suit is optional but preferred.
- Girls: formal pants, skirt or dress (knee-length or longer), formal shoes, fancy blouse.

International Day

If families wish to participate in International Day, please bring clothing related to your country (e.g., traditional dress or country colors). Students and parents may wear this clothing for International Day.

Please Note: Lost items or other personal items can often be found in the lost and found at the main gate. Parents are encouraged to label their children's possessions with the child's name. Parents are notified through the ICS WEEKLY newsletter to check for any lost items, as the lost and found is donated to charity twice a year.
