Practice Kit for ICS Eagles Sport Teams

- In order to better promote school spirit, team unity and our ICS code of conduct, all athletes on a team or practice roster are required to wear the practice t-shirt and PE/practice shorts for each practice—An ISSEA tournament shirt is considered to be acceptable

Section 1 – Certification of Physical Condition

- My signature indicates that my son/daughter has recently (within the last year) had a physical examination and was judged by a physician to be physically fit to participate in sports.

Section 2 – Permission to Participate

- My signature indicates that my daughter/son has permission to participate in the ICS Eagles Athletic program as a member of an athletic team.
- The school is not liable for any injuries incurred while the student is participating in the athletic program or the cost of medical care resulting from any injuries
- I release ICS and its representatives from responsibility for all costs on my behalf and I give permission for the named student to receive immediate medical attention by an adult while the student is in attendance at an athletic contest or practice.
- I am aware that my son/daughter involvement requires attendance at practices and games that may be held on weekdays and weekends at ICS or other locations
- I will support the Athletic Program's position on "dedication to a team" by ensuring—to the best of my ability—my child will display the utmost in responsibility and respect by attending and being punctual to all team practices.
- I understand that if my child does not attend practice, or quits the team, he/she could be removed from future teams.

Section 3 – Equipment/Uniform & Financial Responsibility

- Each ICS athlete is responsible for all athletic equipment (also refers to items belonging to opponents) and uniforms issued to him/her by the Athletic Department.
- This equipment is to be used **only** for practice and games in the specific sport
- Uniforms are not to be worn or used for other purposes (including P.E. class) unless instructed to do so
- It is the responsibility of the athlete to return all equipment and uniforms upon completion of each season
- If equipment or uniforms are stolen, lost, damaged or not returned, the athlete (parents/guardian) will be held responsible for the total replacement cost, including shipping of the item. (average cost to replace a uniform is \$100 US)

Section 4 – Travel for Varsity Athletes

- I understand that athletes may be selected to travel for the ISSEA Varsity tournament and be hosted by students in their homes
- Selection to the Varsity teams does not automatically ensure a traveling position
- Families are responsible for all the costs that are associated with international travel

Section 5 – ICS Eagles Code of Excellence

- **Attendance** – at practice and games is mandatory. A student missing 10% of the season’s sessions can/will be removed from the team. A student must inform the coach prior to any absence and cannot send someone else to pass on this information. Athletes must be in school on the game and practice days; otherwise they cannot participate or watch the match as a spectator. Athletes are expected to be in school the day after an international trip.
- **Athletic Equipment** – Athletes assume responsibility for all equipment issued to them during a game or practice and will be assessed fines or replacement cost for any lost or damaged equipment. No equipment can be taken without the consent of the coach.
- **Travel to Away Games** – Students always travel on the ICS school bus to and from away games. Students are not permitted to travel by their own means.
- **Athletic Conduct** – All students & parents involved in an ISSAAA/ISSEA event and representing ICS must:
 - Always show respect to visiting teams, officials and spectators
 - Respect the integrity and judgment of all officials
 - Understand and practice the rules of the game
 - Recognize the purpose and intent of the ICS athletic program and keep it in perspective
 - Operate with a high level of gratitude for what has been provided for them in this program

Section 6 – ICS Athlete Responsibilities

- **Be Prepared** – I will be ready for all practice, cell phones turned off , dressed out and ready to give their best
- **Lateness** – If I am going to be late, I will bring a note from my teacher. Three unexcused absences will mean I am not committed to the team and I will be removed
- **Stay on top of Grades** – If assignments and grades drop I may be taken off the team
- **Be a positive team member** – I will never criticize a teammate, I will lead by being enthusiastic and industrious, I will accept advice from my coach without complaint and use that information to improve and not offer excuses. I will deal with concerns in a mature manner.
- **Be proud to represent ICS** – I will follow appropriate expectations at all times, not use foul language, display good sportsmanship and keep my emotions under control.
- **Be at my physical and mental best** – I will try to improve everyday, give my best effort in all I do, not complain if I do not play as much as I would like. I will not do anything to jeopardize my performance by smoking, using drugs or have poor sleeping habits.

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- I have read and understood the responsibilities that go along with the **privilege** of being a representative of ICS
 - I will do my best to fulfill my responsibilities from the 1st tryout to the conclusion of the season and to help my teammates fulfill their responsibilities
 - Athletes are required to host visiting schools athletes whenever there are events hosted at ICS Addis
 - **I understand that if I do not fulfill my responsibilities that I will/can be suspended or removed from the team, jeopardizing any future opportunity to represent ICS during the school year**
